The Power of Hope is a national taskforce formed to address racial issues in America in order to find a positive path forward.

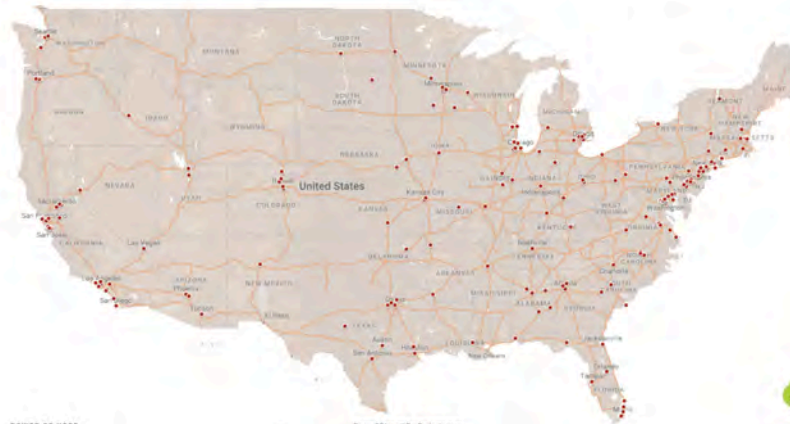
