

2019 Lowenstein Sandler Scholars Program

As a part of **Lowenstein Sandler's** continued commitment to diversity, we proudly present the **2019 Lowenstein Sandler Scholars Program**.

Our **LS Scholars Program** offers 1L law students the opportunity to work side-by-side with attorneys at Lowenstein Sandler, a Leadership Council on Legal Diversity (LCLD) Member law firm, during an 11-week summer internship from May 13 to July 26, 2019. The program also includes an opportunity for our Scholars to attend the 2019 1L LCLD Scholars Summit in Atlanta from June 4 to 6, 2019.

Applicants for the 2019 Lowenstein Sandler Scholars Program must demonstrate an awareness of the importance of promoting diversity as a result of their life experiences, demonstrated interests, background, personal attributes or characteristics. We invite candidates of all ethnicities, sexual orientations and socioeconomic statuses to apply. They must also be currently enrolled, full-time 1L students at accredited law schools, and meet our firm academic standards with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0.

The 2019 LS Scholars Program offers positions in our Roseland, New Jersey office, and will offer a weekly salary of \$3,300.00 in addition to a \$10,000 scholarship toward second-year tuition after successful completion of the 1L Summer Associate Program.

The scholarship may be renewed for the third year if the Scholar is offered and accepts a Summer Associate position with Lowenstein Sandler upon completion of the second year of law school, and maintains a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0. The Scholar would receive a \$15,000 scholarship toward third-year tuition after successful completion of the 2L Summer Associate Program.

To be considered, please submit the following application materials no later than *Friday, February 15, 2019*:

- **Personal essay** (up to 500 words) describing how your ethnicity, sexual orientation, and/or socioeconomic status has impacted your awareness of the importance of diversity. This can be as a result of your life experiences, demonstrated interests, background, personal attributes or characteristics
- Detailed **cover letter** presenting how your unique qualities would enhance the firm and what you would contribute as an LS Scholar
- Current **resume**
- Undergraduate college and law school **transcripts** (Unofficial versions are permitted and can be sent when available)
- **Writing sample** from first semester legal writing course (original student work product)
