### APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants will be considered based on their academic credentials, leadership experience, diversity-related student organization involvement and personal achievements. Applicants will also be asked to submit a personal statement **or** an interest statement, depending on the city to which they are applying.

Applicants will be asked to upload the following materials:

- **Current resume**
- **Undergraduate and law school transcripts** (unofficial transcripts are acceptable)
  - If you apply prior to receiving your first semester law school grades, it will be your responsibility to email your law school transcript to [LCLDProgram@McGuireWoods.com](mailto:LCLDProgram@McGuireWoods.com) by February 1, 2019, in order to complete your application
- **Writing Sample** (limit of 1,000 words) applicants interested in the McGuireWoods/Exelon partnership in our Baltimore office, please use the second prompt.
